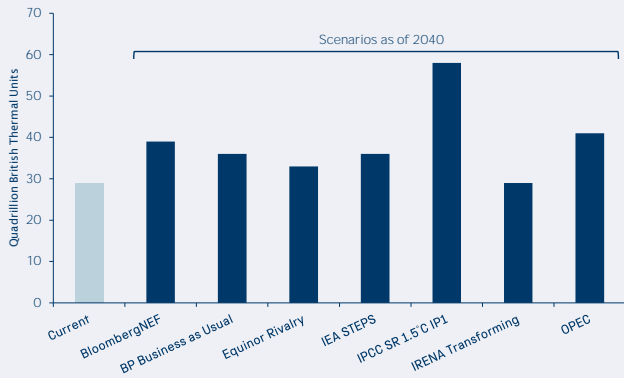
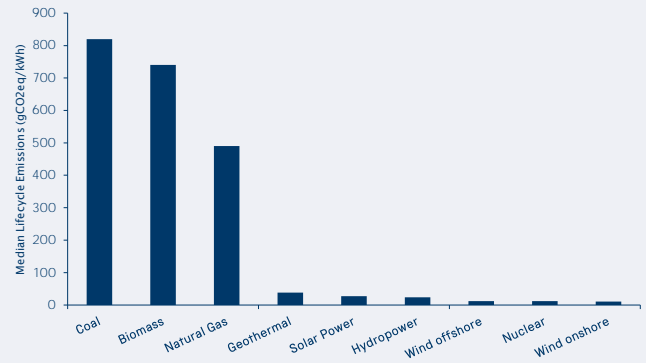


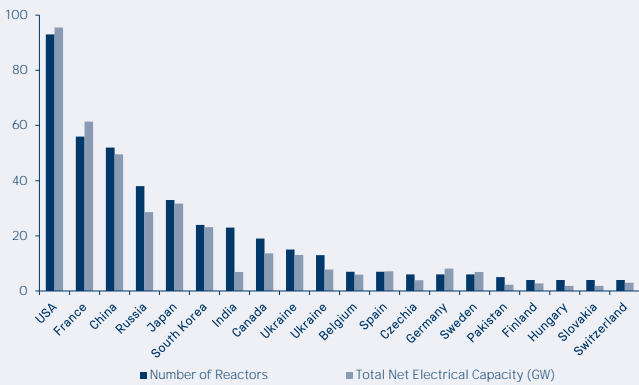
Even pessimistic scenarios assume higher nuclear power consumption



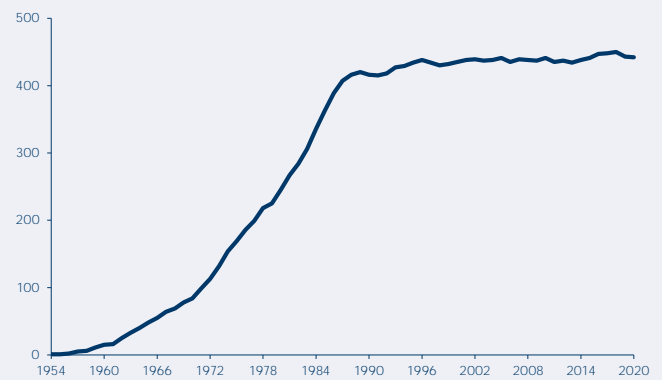
Nuclear power is among the energy sources with the lowest CO₂ emissions



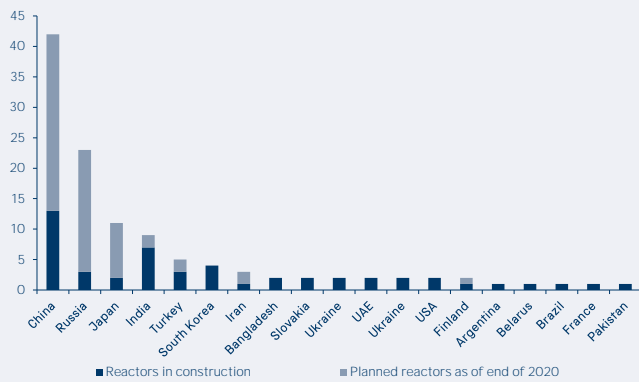
Number of operating nuclear power plants by country



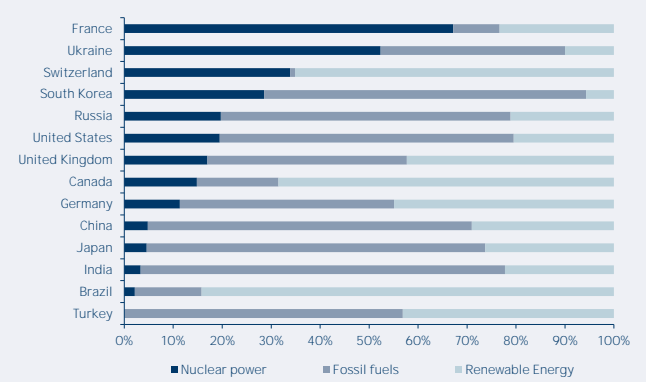
The global number of nuclear power plants has been fairly stable over the past 30 years...



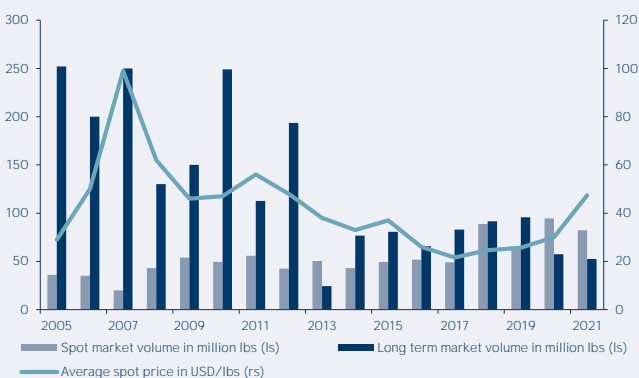
...but especially in emerging markets, new nuclear power plants are being planned and built



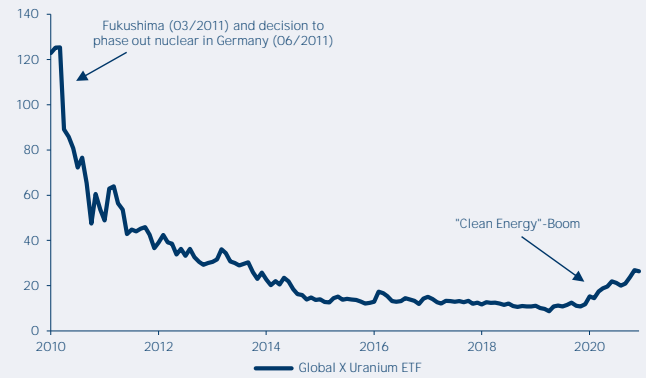
Above all, countries with a high proportion of fossil fuels are building nuclear power plants
